

Holiday Book Purchase @ Barnes & Noble Online



I've included books for Pre-K thru Adulthood.




The Last Day of Summer


Tristan Strong Punches a Hole in the Sky


They Called Us Enemy

A stunning graphic memoir recounting actor/author/activist George Takei's childhood imprisoned within American concentration camps during World War II.




What We Believe: Black Lives Matter
