

Frederick Douglass High School-Virtual Instruction Plan 2021-2022 Quarantined/Isolated Students

Based on the APS Quarantine Instructional Guidance document, the following school-wide plan outlines the process for continuing instruction in a virtual setting for quarantined students.

Quarantined Students

- Students who have been confirmed for COVID-19 exposure or infection are asked to notify Nurse Ikpainyang either by phone or email: 404.802.3127 or <u>nikpainyang@atlanta.k12.ga.us</u>. Students may also contact Ms. Louis-Jean (AP) at 404.802.3127 or <u>kartia.louisjean@atlanta.k12.ga.us</u>.
- Once the student has been placed on quarantine, Ms. Louis-Jean will email all teachers on students' schedule to ensure they complete the following:
 - Verify that Google Classroom assignments are current
 - Contact parent/guardian for further support and provide email contact
 - Contact student through Google Classroom for support on assignments (ongoing through quarantine/isolation process), as needed. Teachers and students may also communicate through email, phone, etc.
- Teachers will also confirm the following with Ms. Louis-Jean within 24 hours:
 - Assignments and any resources needed to complete the assignments (i.e. videos, links, helpful information, etc.) have been posted in Google Classroom
- To ensure the continuation of ESOL, Special Education, SST and 504 services, Ms. Walker (ESOL), Ms. Nunnally Special Education), and/or Mr. Landsman (RTI/SST/504) will also be notified and may be in contact with you.

Please note: When COVID-19 exposure or infection is discovered at the school, Nurse Ikpainyang will make contact with the parent/guardian with quarantine or isolation guidelines. The process will then follow as noted above.

Support for Virtual Instruction

- All students have been provided with their teachers' Google Classroom codes. Students work periodically from Google Classroom while in-person and are familiar with the platform.
- Students may use the email function in My Backpack to email their teachers with any questions or concerns that they have.
- Students may request Zoom tutorial sessions with their teachers while out for quarantine or isolation.



• The tutorial sessions may take place during the teacher's planning period (if available) or during the teacher's after school tutorial time (Wednesdays 4 pm – 5pm).

*ESOL, Special Education and SST/504:
