



## Attention 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> Grade Students: It is Governor's Honors Program (GHP) Time!

**What is GHP?** The Georgia Governor's Honors Program (GHP) is a residential summer program. It is designed to provide students with academic, cultural, and social enrichment.

**Who can apply?** Academically gifted and/or talented 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> grade high school students.

**When is GHP?** GHP is held in mid-summer (mid-June to mid-July) as a residential educational experience on a college or university campus. Meals and rooms are provided by the GHP program.

**Why should I apply to GHP?** GHP produces the next generation of global critical thinkers, innovators, and leaders.

**How can I participate in GHP?** Students can accept a nomination in one of the over forty nomination areas. Teachers will nominate students who excel in a nomination area and are passionate about the nomination area. The nominating teacher, student, and School Based Coordinator will complete online APS-GHP applications. You will need to give the nominating teacher **your and your parent email address and number** to start the nomination process.

**What if I am nominated in more than one nomination area?** You may only apply for GHP in one area.

**What happens once my application is complete?** Once all three parts of the APS-GHP application have been completed and reviewed. The nominee will be assigned an interview time for a District Level Interview.

**When are the interviews for GHP?** Selected nominees will receive an invitation from district content coordinators to interview within a two-week window: October 26 – November 6, 2020.

**What happens after the District Level interviews?** The District Level Nominees compete to become a GHP District Level Finalist.

**What happens if I interviewed at State last year?** You may reapply this year. (Finalists are not eligible.)

**Whom should I contact if I have a few more questions?** You should speak to your School Based GHP Contact or Counselor.
