

## **Summer Student Worker Distribution Lineworker – Georgia Power**

Georgia Power's line crews play an integral part in Georgia's economy. Hospitals, government agencies, schools, businesses, and individuals rely on lineworkers to provide reliable electric service. If you're looking for a position in which you can make a difference and serve Georgians, consider becoming a lineworker with Georgia Power.

### **Job Scope:**

- Develop a general knowledge of power lines construction standards.
- Work with line crews daily doing basic work activities.
- Use basic hand tools: shovel, bush hook, post hole diggers, and other basic tools.
- Help prepare overhead and underground materials for installation.
- Assist with power outage restoration if they occur during scheduled work hours.
- Interact with Georgia Power customers while in the field.
- Time designated for CAST (Construction and Skills Trade) prep and soft skills training.

### **Student Worker Requirements:**

- Graduating senior class of 2020 or 2021, preference 18 years of age or older (must be 18 by, September 1<sup>st</sup>).
- Responsible individual with reliable transportation to and from work (valid driver's license required).
- Ability to read, understand, and follow procedures, rules, and regulations.
- Ability to perform physically demanding activities while working outside in all conditions (exception – rain).
- Must pass pre-employment screening (drug testing and physical). Georgia Power – Smoke-Free Workplace Policy: You must be free from all tobacco products (include but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, chew, snuff, patch and/or gum), at least six months prior to applying for this position.
- Must be drug free and follow safety protocol if prescription drug(s) required.
- Ability to comprehend basic safety rules and not be afraid to ask questions.
- Positive attitude, strong work ethic, willingness to take the initiative and follow instructions.
- Ability to receive constructive feedback.
- The interest and aptitude in linework as a future career path.

### **Program Details:**

- This is a paid internship: \$10.00/hour (there is no overtime or mileage reimbursement).
- The program is approximately 8 weeks, with a preferred start time in June. (This will be tentative depending on stay-in-place order & social distancing policy)
- Schedule: Monday through Friday – 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. (may vary slightly based on work location)
- Work location: TBD – will be based on candidate's home location.
  - Note: there will be a reporting location, but the student will ride with crew members to various work locations daily. The student should be prepared to be out with crews most days and return to the office location by 3:30.
- Reporting Supervisor: TBD
- Every aspect of the internship will be closely supervised and evaluated by a full-time Georgia Power employee.

### **Dress Code (all will be provided):**

- Steel toe work boots
- Appropriate jeans and shirt – 100% cotton or natural fiber
- Additional fire-retardant gear
- Personal Protection Equipment (PPE)
