Thank you for your interest in the Fernbank Youth Interpreter (FYI) volunteer program at Fernbank Museum of Natural History. FYI volunteers are essential to many of our educational programs, as well as helping to provide many one-on-one educational experiences for our visitors. We are currently seeking volunteers to start during the **summer of 2022** and become part of our June 2022 – May 2023 FYI Volunteer team.

- **Two** reference forms. Reference forms must be completed by adults who are not related to you. One reference must be from a teacher (science teacher preferred) or counselor. Homeschool students may use a non-relative reference from scouts, music lessons, sports, etc.

Please read the Frequently Asked Questions, found at the end of the application, before applying. Incomplete applications will not be accepted, so please enter your information on all forms carefully.

Once your complete application is received, all materials will be reviewed. If you are selected for an interview, you will be contacted directly by a Fernbank Education staff member by email. Please make sure you provide *legible* and accurate email addresses and phone numbers; multiple email addresses are ideal in case any of our emails get blocked or flagged as spam.

Interviews will take place at the end of March and beginning of April. Please read the interview tips listed in the Frequently Asked Questions section before your scheduled interview. If you are selected for the program after the interview, training will begin after the school year in May or the beginning of June.

FYI Volunteer Frequently Asked Questions

When can a youth become a FYI volunteer?

Youth can apply to be a volunteer during spring recruitment. New FYI volunteers are only accepted at this time and not all applicants are accepted into the program. Applicants who applied in previous years, but were not invited into the program, are encouraged to reapply. FYI volunteers accepted into the program begin volunteering in June.

How old do you have to be to volunteer?

All interested FYI volunteers must be a minimum of 13 years old by September 1, 2022 to apply. New applicants should be a maximum of 17 years old by June 1, 2022. FYI Volunteers who turn 18 during the FYI year (June 2022 through May 2023) remain in the volunteer program until the end of the season. All interested applicants 18 and older may apply to participate in our adult volunteer program.

What type of commitment is required to be a FYI volunteer?

FYI volunteers commit to one year, which runs from June through May of the following year. FYI volunteers are required to dedicate a minimum of 45 hours throughout the year, or one shift per month during the school year and two shifts per month during the summer (June and July). Shifts are generally 3 to 4.5 hours long, but can vary for special activities. All FYI volunteers must attend a new volunteer orientation and additional trainings throughout the year may be required for other opportunities. New FYI volunteers must also pay a onetime \$50 fee to participate, which helps cover materials. This fee will be collected after being accepted into the program and before your initial training. The fee may be waived for those that qualify—contact the FYI Volunteer Manager upon acceptance to the program if needed.

If accepted, can I volunteer for more than one year?

Once accepted into the program, FYI volunteers can continue volunteering in following years. Every year a recommitment form is sent to all active volunteers. FYI volunteers who are interested in continuing with the program agree to commit an additional 45 hours for the coming June - May year and return the recommitment form. Those continuing with the program do not have to pay an additional \$50 fee.

Those who turn 18 years old or graduate high school over the course of the year, age out of the program at the end of May. Volunteers who age out of the FYI program, but would like to keep volunteering with the museum, may join our adult volunteer program.

What kind of benefits do FYI volunteers receive?

FYI volunteers receive ongoing educational experiences, training in science communication, training for various science topics, a volunteer uniform t-shirt, discounts at the Museum Stores, discounts in the Fernbank café, and free admission to Fernbank Museum and the Giant Screen Theater with their nametag. Educational and social activities may also be offered at various times, as well as recognition for achievements, Presidential Service Awards and a thank you gift for every 50 hours worked. FYI volunteers work side by side with real Fernbank Museum scientists, gain public speaking skills, presentation skills, and learn about natural history in a unique setting. In addition, a few advanced opportunities are only extended to FYI volunteers who have achieved 50 hours or more of service with the museum.

Do FYI volunteers have a uniform?

FYI volunteers are required to wear the FYI t-shirt and name badge when volunteering, which will be provided at training. Non-athletic shorts/pants/skirts and shoes are also required.



I've been selected for an interview, what can I expect?

Practice interviewing ahead of time with an adult or a friend. We'll be asking you about your personality, interests, academics, and how you might fit at Fernbank Museum. Be prepared enough to make a good impression, but not so much that you seem rehearsed and unnatural. Be confident and enthusiastic! If you're unfamiliar with Fernbank Museum, learn more about us at www.fernbankmuseum.org.

Here are some examples of the kind of questions we might ask:

- Why do you want to be a FYI volunteer? (more than just "it will be fun")
- Why are you a good candidate to be a FYI volunteer?
- What skills do you expect to learn as a FYI volunteer?
- How do you expect guests want to be treated when visiting Fernbank Museum?
- Be able to identify and discuss your strengths and skills.

The FYI Volunteer program is very competitive and we are unfortunately not able to accept everyone who applies or interviews each year. Candidates who are not accepted or invited for an interview this year are encouraged to reapply next year.
