WHAT: The Jefferson Scholarship is a four-year merit scholarship to the University of Virginia. The scholarship also includes an extensive enrichment program which supports and nurtures students throughout their four years, as well as provide access to a community of other scholars, graduate fellows, staff, and alumni.

To be eligible for the Jefferson Scholarship you must:

- Be a competitive applicant to the University of Virginia
 - Be on track to graduate in the spring
- Demonstrate the highest qualities of Leadership, Scholarship, & Citizenship
 - Not apply to a binding early decision commitment at another University or College

Awarded solely based on merit, Jefferson Scholarships are granted to candidates who have undergone a rigorous selection process through the University of Virginia.

HOW: Midtown High School's committee composed of instructional members, counselors, and administration may nominate two students for the Jefferson Scholars Program. Students interested in consideration for nomination must submit via email to their assigned school counselor –

- Your resume
- Your highest SAT/ACT scores
- Your highest AP Scores

WHEN: Please submit required items by Friday November 11, 2022. Students will be notified via email regarding his/her nomination and the next steps outlined by the University of Virginia.
