School Counseling Mission Statement

In a caring culture of trust and collaboration, the mission of the Atlanta Public Schools Guidance and Counseling Department is to provide high quality, comprehensive school counseling services to all students. Our programs are designed to help students develop and enhance their academic, behavioral, career, and personal/social strengths in order to ensure that all students graduate ready for college and career.

Statement of Philosophy

Guidance and counseling are vital and integral components of the educational program of Henry W. Grady High School that support the academic, personal/social, and career development of all students. The School Counseling Department believes that it is the function of the school to provide our students with opportunities and challenges that allow them to function effectively in a changing society.
