AP courses: 10 point weight is added to individual semester course grades of 70 and above on the transcript. 10 point weight is also added to the final grade for each core content/world language dual enrollment course with a grade of 70 and above.

Class rank is determined by the numeric average for all subjects taken in grades 9-12. Class rank is reported at the end of the fall semester of the senior year. Valedictorian and Salutatorian is confirmed at the end of fall semester of the senior year.

Schedule Design

Having been virtual almost the entire school year, Atlanta Public School scholars experienced a year like no other in 2020-2021. To provide an extra layer of support to the scholars for our 2020-2021 reopening model, the district made the decision for all Traditional APS High Schools to move to a 4x4 schedule design. The district resumed its 4x8 schedule design for the 2021-2022 school year.

Midtown High School is a four-year college preparatory and career technology high school located within midtown Atlanta. Rigorous curriculum include honors, Advanced Placement, and dual enrollment options.
