In preparation for the poetry slam, each host will set up a space in the media center where their students will go to share their poems.

Participants:

-Students can choose to participate as a group (no more than 5 students) or individually.

-Students are allowed to pre-record their entries but must be present virtually on the day of the event. Live Performances are strongly encouraged.

-Students may use notecards but works must be original.

-Each entry must have a title and a topic for a point of reference.

-Students must refrain from using profanity, and derogatory language.

-If a student is using music, it must be instrumental and clean.

-Performance cannot exceed 1minute (60 seconds)

-Students must be prepared to introduce themselves and their performance.
