Greetings Raider Family,



Dates and Deadlines:

March 11th - Flyers to be distributed

April 12th- All entries submitted to the Media Specialist/Para (or designee)

April 15th- Virtual Poetry Slam from 9:30-12:00 noon

Responsibilities of the host LMS/Media Para (or designee):

Each Media Specialist/Paraprofessional (or designee) will be responsible for hosting the poetry slam and their participants in their school's media center at the designated time.

The host at each school will be responsible for student performances at their school and will review and vet all material to be shared with the school (district) community.

In preparation for the poetry slam, each host will set up a space in the media center where their students will go to share their poems.

Participants:

-Students can choose to participate as a group (no more than 5 students) or individually.

-Students are allowed to pre-record their entries but must be present virtually on the day of the event. **Live Performances are strongly encouraged.**

-Students may use notecards but works must be original.

-Each entry must have a title and a topic for a point of reference.

-Students must refrain from using profanity, and derogatory language.
