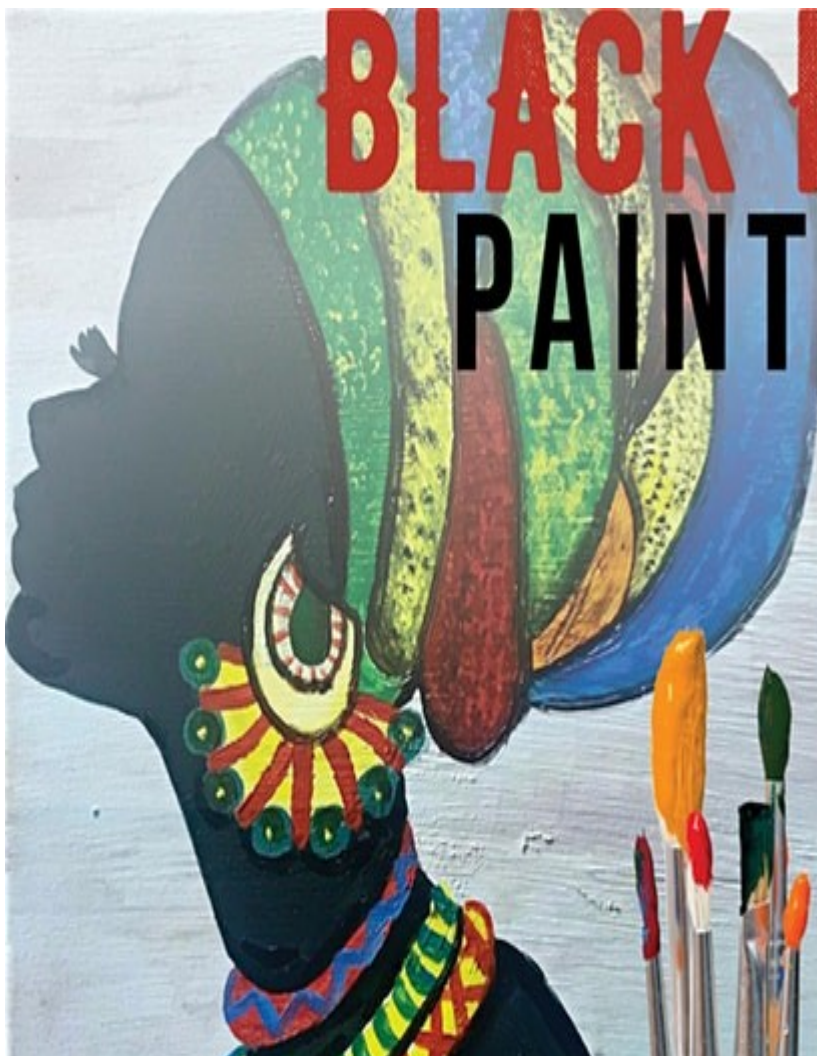

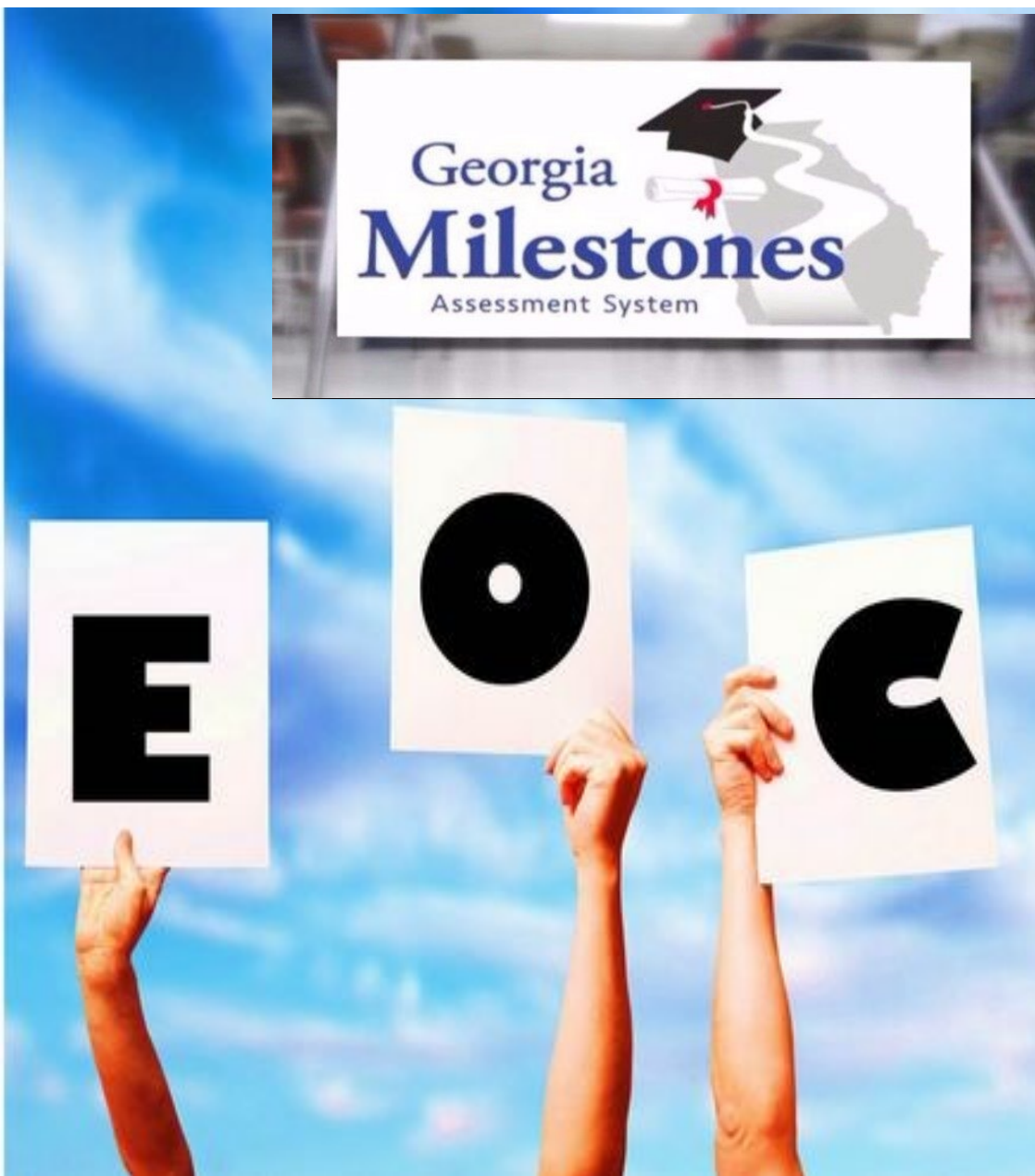
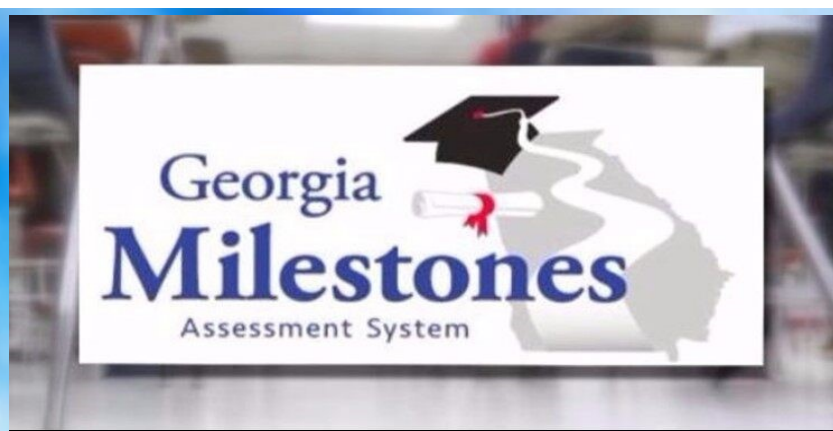

Public school students enrolled in and/or receiving credit for one of these courses, regardless of grade level, are required to take the Georgia Milestone assessment upon completion of the course. The results of the EOC assessments will serve as the final exam in each course, contributing to the student's final course grade. Students enrolling at B. E. Mays High School are required to take and pass the Georgia Milestones EOC assessment prior to receiving credit for the course. 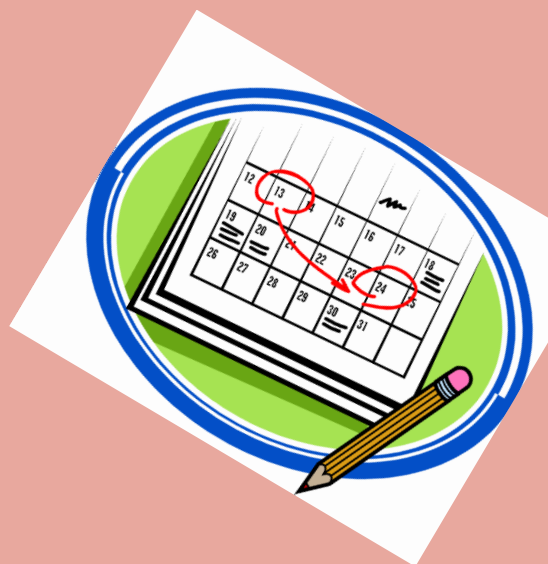

The criteria for the selection of the college bound student will consist of:

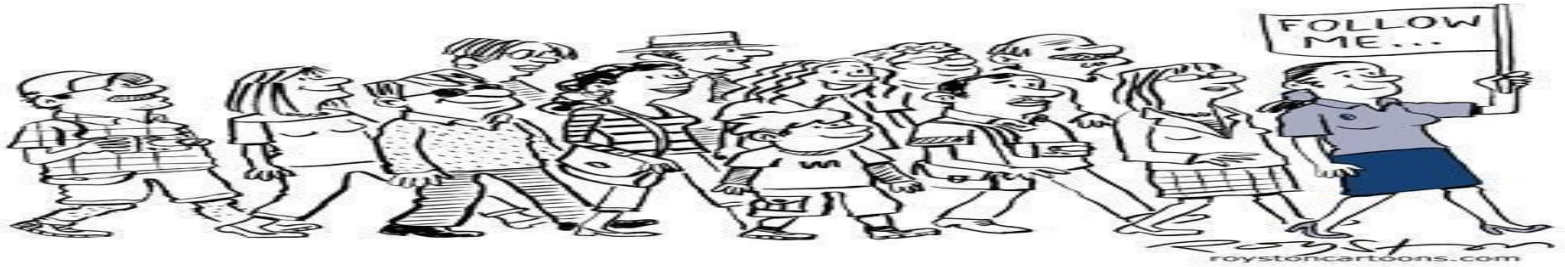
