Not to mention taking time off from work, negotiating with traffic, children missing school which could impact attendance and grade performances. Schools also love this aspect because schools don't want poor attendance records, grade scores, nor a flu epidemic spread throughout the school which impacts workforce and avoidable labor cost for substituting teachers and/or staff.

• <u>Compliancy</u> – We only use ACIP recommended and FDA approved vaccines. Our program aides in improving students and schools attendance and grade scoring matrixes. With our Spring SLVC's schools are enabled to meet compliancy with state required vaccination of students with TDAP coupled with our offering of Meningococcal A, C, W, Y & B vaccines for appropriate students for current and upcoming school year. All vaccine records are entered into the state of Georgia registry – GRITS.

• <u>Commitment</u> – Our pledge, focus and efforts are to help keep students/people, our families/households and communities healthy while you keep them smart and prepare them for the workforce. We want to empower students/parents/schools/workforces with readily available vaccine(s) that can improve their quality of life and meet state requirements regarding vaccination(s) and absenteeism and/or involuntary time off work. We offer vaccination for all students regardless of insurance coverage (Medicaid, uninsured, underinsured as well as most private insurance providers) accompanied with a signed Health Heroes of Georgia consent form by legal parent/guardian.
