# M.H. JACKSON HIGH SCHOOL 2017-2018 Dress Code

# Our dress code is strictly enforced Monday through Friday.

- 1. Khaki bottoms shorts, pants, skorts, and skirts (plus a plaid skirt option for girls at Charter Uniforms).
- Solid knit <u>collared</u> polo-style shirts (black, white, gold, crimson, and burgundy) or white oxford shirts are required. MH Jackson <u>Monogram</u> Shirts are preferred.
- 3. All outerwear should be solid school colors or school-related. This includes vests, sweaters, and jackets. Monogram items are available at Charter Uniforms and through various school organizations.
- 4. M.H. Jackson athletic shirts, club shirts, and class shirts may be worn daily with Khaki pants.
- 5. Uniforms will be worn Monday through Friday (Jean and Spirit Days will be announced and often serve as fundraisers).

#### TOPS:

- <u>Solid</u> knit collared polo-style shirts (black, white, gold, crimson, and burgundy).
- Long sleeved, white Oxford shirt.
- M.H. Jackson athletic shirts, club shirts, and class shirts may be worn daily with Khaki pants.

#### BOTTOMS: (Only Khaki Bottoms or Approved Plaid)

- Girls: Shorts, skorts, dress pants or skirts in khaki or MHJHS plaid skirt. Skirts, shorts and skorts must be no more than 3" above the knee.
- Boys: Shorts or dress pants in khaki.

# **ACCESSORIES:**

- Brown or black belts.
- Ties (MHJHS school colors) and cross ties (MHJHS plaid) from Charter School Uniforms.

# **OUTER WEAR**:

- Outer wear should be solid school TOPS colors. This includes vests, sweaters, sweatshirts, and jackets. Monogram items are available at Charter and our PTSA Spirit Store.
- Knit-lined windbreaker in approved TOPS colors.
- Burgundy Blazer or Cardigan.
- School sweatshirts/hoodies (sold by the PTSA, athletics, and other school organizations).

Outerwear that does not conform to uniform policy should be placed in your locker throughout the day.

# **SHOES:**

• No slides, flip-flops, slippers or backless shoes.

# BACKPACKS:

• Must be CLEAR or MESH.

\*We reserve the right to adjust the dress code should concerns or issues arise throughout the school year. In such an event, parents and students will be notified in advance of the change(s).

#### Additional uniform expectations:

- No bandanas, head wraps, or bonnets
- No hats or hoods should be worn
- No non-approved shirts worn over the uniform
- No exposed midriffs or excessively tight or short clothing.
- Accessories should not alter the appearance of the uniform dress code
- No spikes, chains, or potentially dangerous items are allowed as accessories
- No visible underwear
- No vulgar, profane, or offensive clothing or accessories.
- No drug, alcohol, or gang-related clothing or accessories.
- No undershirts or tank-tops worn as shirts
- No holes or tears in uniform pants
- No tights, leggings, or similar items worn as pants
- No dresses, including shirt and khaki style

\*The administration will have final say on the appropriateness of a student's uniform. We will work to correct any issues in a positive and productive manner.

\*Jeans and Spirit Days will be announced in advance to parents and students. They will serve as fundraisers for student activities and events.
