High-level Overview

Safety Protocols/PPE/ Student Transitions

- Students will maintain social distancing, six feet apart. In class, student desk will be six feet apart and all students will have desk shields.
- Students are expected to wear mask to school and throughout the entire school day.
- The school will have additional PPE on hand for students and staff. All staff members have been provided with protective shields.
- If students present with a fever (100.4 & up), the student will be escorted to the CARE room which is monitored by a non instructional aide. Parents will be asked to pick up the student. Students will not be allowed to return to school until they are fever free for 48 hours without the assistance of medicine.
- If the parent does not have transportation, a CARE bus will be available to transport the student and a staff member to the child's house as long as there is someone available to receive him/her.
- Transitions throughout the school will be limited to arrival, restroom breaks, PE, and dismissal.

Nutrition

- Meals will be transported to the classroom for breakfast and lunch.
- Students will eat in the classroom.
- Bins will be in the classroom for students to discard their lunches.

School Instructional Model/Schedule

- Face to face and virtual instruction will be offered based on the intent to return surveys.
- We will resume our regular scheduled hours:
Drop off 7:30-8:00 AM
Instruction 8:00-2:30 PM
Dismissal 2:30-3:00 PM

Transportation

- Carpool Monitors will take the temperatures of students prior to them exiting the car. If students present with a fever (100.4 & up), the parent will be asked to take them home. Students will not be allowed to return to school until they are fever free for 48 hours without the assistance of medicine.
- Carpool lane monitors will record students' temperatures.
- If students present with a fever once they've been dropped off (100.4 & up), the student will be escorted to the CARE room which is monitored by a non instructional aide
- Buses will be unloaded at the bus loop one at a time. Students will exit the bus 3-5 students at a time six feet apart wait to enter the building upon entering the building students will stop at temperature check point one at a time.
- Bus monitors will record students' temperatures.
- If students present with a fever once they've been dropped off (100.4 & up), the student will be escorted to the CARE room which is monitored by a non instructional aide. Other students will be escorted to their classrooms by staff.
