

Enrollment and School Facility Utilization Report 2024-25 SY

(December 2, 2024)

Introduction

Atlanta Public Schools hired a consulting firm to develop a Facilities Master Plan (FMP) in October 2019. The plan was completed in July 2022 after a pause during the COVID pandemic. One of the recommendations by the consultant was for the APS Planning & GIS team (within the Operations Division) to perform an annual review of enrollment projections and utilization (enrollment divided by capacity) for each school in the district.

Enrollment Change from 2023-24 SY

The district added 285 students in 2024-25 as compared to last year – from 49,660 to 49,945. Jackson, Midtown, and North Atlanta clusters experienced a small growth while Therrell and Washinton clusters saw declines. Carver, Douglass, Mays, South Atlanta clusters, and Charter schools remained relatively flat. The FTE counts for 2024-25 are shown in Appendix I in Table 15. The table below shows the enrollment changes by cluster over last year. Partner schools are included in the geographic clusters. Centennial Charter is included in the Midtown cluster (as it serves an attendance zone).

Projections

Enrollment projections for the next five school years are developed using a combination of historic enrollment trends (Figure 7 in Appendix I) and number of live births in the city (Figure 8 in Appendix I). Historic enrollment trends generally reflect residential development patterns, but student yield rates for new construction, based on residential building permits issued by the City of Atlanta, are also analyzed and incorporated into projections in areas where new residential development has rapidly accelerated.

Kindergarten (KK) enrollment is projected based on number of live births and US Census data. Historic capture rates (live births 5-6 years prior in each elementary school zone as compared to the kindergarten enrollment , see Figure 8 in Appendix I) are used to generate projected kindergarten enrollments for the next five years.

Progression rates based on historic enrollment data by school and grade are used to project enrollments for grades 01-12 at each neighborhood school. This process includes calibration of the model based on an

analysis of the accuracy of prior years' projections and adjustments to the progression rates. The projected and historic enrollment by school is shown in Appendix I in Table 16 and utilization charts in Appendix II.


Utilization at each school is calculated based on capacity and projected enrollment. Capacities for each facility are calculated by class size and number of core classrooms available. Class sizes for capacity calculations are shown in Appendix I in Table 17.

Planning & GIS staff update enrollment projections annually, compare enrollments with facility capacity to assess utilization, and share projections and capacity with principals for review. This review by the principals was conducted in November of this year. The enrollment and capacities in this report reflect any feedback received from the principals. Capacities for each facility are listed in Appendix I in Tables 18 through 21.

Results

The following chart shows the district's historic enrollment, capacity, and utilization for the last 10 years and projections for the next five years. Total enrollment (PK-12) for the current year (2024-25) is 40,386 – excluding charter and non-traditional schools but including Centennial Academy (conversion charter) – while the district has over 62,000 total seats at these schools. The current utilization for the district is 65% which represents over 21,000 excess seats. Projections indicate that enrollment will fluctuate around 40,000 and utilization rate remains at 65%.


Figure 1. District Enrollment*: 2014-15 to 2029-30



Figure 2. Elementary School Enrollment*: 2014-15 to 2029-30





Figure 3. Middle School Enrollment*: 2014-15 to 2029-30





Based on the analysis of projected enrollment, capacity, and utilization, APS has developed triggers for action as shown in Table 2.

A timeline to address over-capacity schools is discussed below in Next Steps.

Schools that have projected utilizations less than 90% based on capacity and projected enrollment are identified, and students from outside the zone are allowed to enroll next school year as part of the general administrative transfer process.

Schools with less than 95% utilization are allowed to enroll out of zone students of staff who work at other schools and administrative facilities in the cluster.


Based on the projected utilization in the next five years, the schools have been grouped into five categories. The following table shows the number of schools in each category by cluster.

- January-December 2025: We will review dual campuses in Spring 2025 and will engage throughout 2025 to address overcrowding and under-enrollment in APS schools. Through cluster-level engagement, we will ensure schools are at an appropriate capacity to benefit student learning and experience.
- November (Board First Read, if needed): Share and receive feedback on the Superintendent's recommendation to the board as first read.
- December (Board Second Read, if needed): Board votes on the Superintendent's recommendation.









Map 1. Elementary Schools by Utilization Category (26-27 SY)




Map 2. Middle Schools by Utilization Category (26-27 SY)
