Appropriate Attire/Appearance 2022-2023

Please see below regarding specific inappropriate attire and/or appearance violations:

1. NO Croc-styled footwear, flip-flops, slides, shower shoe, bare feet, etc. are permitted in classrooms, the cafeteria, or any other public/indoor venues.
2. NO Caps, do-rags and/or hoods are permitted in classrooms, the cafeteria, or other indoor venues. *This policy item does not apply to headgear considered as a part of religious or cultural dress.*
3. NO Sunglasses or “shades” are not to be worn in class or at formal programs unless *medical documentation is provided to support use.*
4. NO Decorative orthodontic appliances (e.g., “grills”), are permitted; be they permanent or removable, they shall not be worn on the school site.
5. NO Clothing with derogatory, offensive, or lewd messages (*either in words or pictures*) are allowed.
6. NO sagging – *the wearing of one’s pants low enough to reveal undergarments or secondary layers of clothing.*
7. NO gym shorts or pajamas shall be worn while in school.
8. The following appearance enhancers MAY NOT be worn at school:

NO earrings (MS only)

NO fake eyelashes

NO eyeliner

NO hair extensions/wigs

NO hair coloring

NO lipstick

NO make-up

NO nose-rings

NO painted or acrylic nails

** Due to the complex nature of our dress code policy, administration reserves the right to handle all dress-code violations in a case-by-case manner. Additional dress regulations may be imposed/revised when students are participating in certain extracurricular activities that are considered auxiliaries (e.g., Athletic teams, the Band, Chorus, Clubs, etc.).*

The school reserves the right to modify this policy as deemed appropriate. All administrative, faculty, students and support staff members are asked to assist in enforcing this policy and should report violations. Failure to comply with this policy is a violation of the Code of Student Conduct. Students may be given a verbal warning to correct their attire by a faculty or staff member. Should the student choose not to abide by the directives of a faculty or staff member, this is a violation of our Code of Student Conduct for “failure to comply,” then they will be referred to administration. Frequent and or excessive violations will be subject to our Code of Student Conduct consequences.
