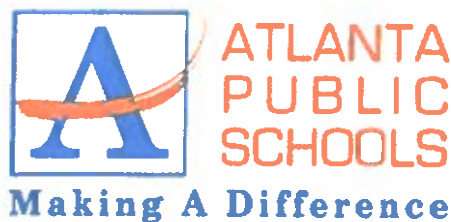

Welcome to the 2022/23 school year at Coretta Scott King Young Women's Leadership Academy. We are highly anticipating and excited about a phenomenal school year riddled with new initiatives, widespread academic exposure and experiences. This year we are striving to provide a true private school experience in our public - choice school. Although we are growing in numbers, we have worked to maintain small class sizes 20:1 in our core content classes.

Our goal for the upcoming school year is to continue in our strides to support academic intervention, restoration and enrichment while preparing our young ladies for college and career readiness. In making this goal a reality, we are planning academic exposure and experiences that champion status quo. This exposure includes field trips in-state and out-of-state 😊. This year, we will continue to focus on project-based learning units in STEAM, college readiness and ACT/SAT preparation. As an Early College/STEM Signature/pathway school, each child will be able to follow a program of study that results in students not only graduating with a high school diploma, but they will also receive certification in a specialized field or the attainment of credits towards a post-secondary degree. In addition, middle school students will receive exposure to four world languages in their strides to receive high school credit.

STUDENT DAILY EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Students are expected to report to school between 8:15 a.m. and 8:40 a.m. in order to report to advisory by 8:45 a.m.**
- 2. Students should report to each class on time. Attendance will be taken during the first 15 minutes of each class to note whether students are present, absent, or tardy.**
- 3. Students should come dressed according to the CSK dress code. (Khaki or chocolate brown pants with pink, white or brown collared shirt (no hair bonnets, hair scarves, or bandanas etc.)**
- 4. Students should come prepared with the school supplies needed to complete all learning tasks (laptops, chargers, paper, pencil, notebook etc.)**
- 5. Laptops will be issued to all students. * Continuing students must return their 21/22 assigned laptop before being issued a device.**
- 6. Students are expected to attend tutorial sessions/Saturday school for additional support in any classes with missing assignments or failing grades.**
