The Atlanta Public Schools' Maynard H. Jackson High School project receives an "Award of Excellence" from the Atlanta Urban Design Commission

ATLANTA – An APS high school campus that recently underwent extensive renovations, expansion and modernizations earned an "Award of Excellence" recognition from the Atlanta Urban Design Commission.



The Maynard H. Jackson High School project was recognized yesterday evening at the Commission's 38th annual ceremony held at Morehouse College's Ray Charles Performing Arts Center. The school facility and campus recently underwent an extensive multi-million dollar redesign, renovation, expansion and modernization. The \$48.2m project that opened in January 2014 was designed by Perkins + Will, Architects and built by Winter Construction Company.



The award was among several recognitions presented to projects city wide in 2015 by the commission and represents the seventh such award that Atlanta Public Schools' capital improvement projects have received since 2004.

The Commission membership includes two architects, as well as a landscape architect, lawyer, land developer, real estate professional, historic preservationist, artist, historian, neighborhood representative, and urban planner. The annual awards are in recognition of excellence in innovative design and quality construction of building and land development projects across the City of Atlanta.
