PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Child must turn four years old by September 1, 2024
- Child must live within the APS attendance zone



HOW TO APPLY

- **Pre-K lottery applications accepted February 1 through March 1, 2024**
- Apply online at enrollearlyatl.com starting at 9 am (eastern time) on February 1, 2024
- A valid email address is required to apply
- Applications must be received by 11:59 pm (eastern time) on March 1, 2024



LOTTERY DRAWING

- **The lottery drawing will be held on March 15, 2024**
- Lottery drawing results will be emailed to all applicants after verification process. Pending official verification, lottery results could be delayed.

◆ Benteen, Garden Hills and Sarah Smith Elem(pending). offer a traditional Pre-K and a DLI Pre-K program. Each site has a capacity of 20 for the traditional Pre-K class. The Dual Language class will accept 10 English and 10 Spanish speaking students. Students who are zoned to the school will receive priority placement into DLI programs.



THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ENROLLMENT:

- Child's original birth certificate or passport
- Child's original social security card
- Proof of legal guardianship (if applicable).
Only required if your name is not on the child's birth certificate.
- Child's health insurance card
- Parent/guardian I.D.
State I.D., passport, or driver's license
- Proof of food stamps, Medicaid, TANF (if applicable)
- Proof of residency
Lease, deed, or mortgage statement, AND Georgia Power bill in parent/guardian name (cable, phone, water, and gas bills **are not** accepted).
If you are living with someone you will need the following:
 - Immunization certificate (Form 3231)
 - Ear, eye, and dental screening (Form 3300)
 - Proof of income – **Head Start sites ONLY****
 - 2023 W2 or tax return, or 2024 SSI/TANF/SNAP award or determination letter
 - If you did not work or file taxes, a non-income declaration form will be provided to you.
 - A valid lease/mortgage statement or deed **AND** Georgia Power bill in the homeowner's name.
 - A notarized Affidavit of residency.
 - Three forms of mail in your name with the homeowner's address.
