



Dual language immersion is a form of education in which students are taught literacy and content in two languages.

Opportunities

Dual Immersion students are better prepared to collaborate and communicate across linguistic and political boundaries, and have broad career opportunities.



Seal of Biliteracy

Dual Immersion students receive a diploma seal for achievement of high level of proficiency in one or more languages in addition to English on high school diploma.



Biliteracy

Dual Language Immersion students acquire a new language and preserve native language.



High Academic Achievement

Based on longitudinal research Dual Immersion students perform as well as or better than non-immersion students on standardized tests of language arts and mathematics, even when these tests are administered in English.
