What is Title I?

West Manor Elementary School (West Manor) is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). What is it?

This is a plan that describes how West Manor Elementary School will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. How is it developed?

West Manor Elementary School invited all parents to attend our parent input meeting to review and revise this parent and family engagement plan, our school-parent compact, and provide feedback on the parent and family engagement budget. West Manor Elementary School will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

1. Decrease the percentage of 3rd-5th grade students in the Beginning and Developing categories in all content areas by 3%.
2. Increase the percentage of 3rd-5th grade students in the Proficient and Distinguished categories in all content areas by 3%.
3. To increase the percentage of K-2 students receiving on grade level scores on STAR Reading and Math by 3%.

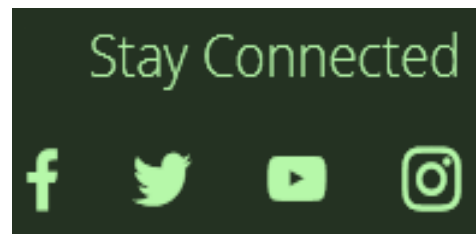
