

# Virtual Instructional Plan for Quarantined Students 2021-2022

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Based on the APS Quarantine Instructional Guidance document, the following Virtual Instructional Plan for Herman J. Russell West End Academy outlines the process for continuing instruction in a virtual setting for quarantined students.

### **Quarantined Students:**

- Once a student has been quarantined, HJRWEA School Nurse (Ms. Brown) will update HJRWEA COVID Absence Report located in a shared Google drive to inform teachers and the administrative staff of student absences. HJR West End Academy's school clerk will notify parents to:
  - Pick up a device from the school (if the student does not already have an assigned device from the school) & Virtual Learning Welcome Packet (Parent Notification Letter, Viral Solutions Testing Consent Form, Device Acknowledgement Receipt, COVID Testing Locations near school, COVID Mitigation Strategies
  - Complete daily assignments in Google Classroom.

Ms. Leverette, Special Education Lead Teacher and Ms. Porter, MTSS Specialist will review HJRWEA COVID Absence Report daily to ensure that students receive their identified services.

- Within 24 hours, grade Level Support Personnel (6th Grade N. Phillips, 7th Grade D. Powell, and 8th Grade T. Browning):
  - Will contact parents to complete student wellness checks and to ensure that parents/students understand how to access Google Classroom via myBackpack.com and understand class assignment completion expectations. (Inform your Assistant Principal if you have trouble reaching a parent or if a student has not logged onto class).
  - Monitor if teachers have the following posted in Google Classroom: (Assignments; resources needed to complete the assignments i.e. videos, links, helpful information, etc. ).





#### **Device Distribution:**

- Parents will be contacted if there is a need to pick up a device from the school.
- If students have an assigned device, they will take the device home along with a letter for quarantine steps and a parent virtual learning instruction brochure.

#### Internet Access:



- If parents come to the school requesting a hotspot in the front office, office personnel will also be able to add the parent's name to the HJRWEA Hotspot Request Excel spreadsheet. Ms. Sims will review and submit the request to APS.
- Once the hotspot is delivered to the school, Ms. Sims will contact the parent. Parents will only receive one hotspot per household.
  \*Note: Names will be added to the spreadsheet only when there is a parent request.





#### Virtual Instruction for Quarantined Scholars:

The H.J. Russell West End Academy's Virtual Learning Plan is designed to provide instruction and tutorial while students are out due to COVID-19 or other extenuating circumstances. There are four Virtual Learning models.

#### **Quarantine Timeline:**

Close Contact/Exposure to a confirmed COVID case:	Confirmed COVID 19 Positive Test:
Can return on day 7 of quarantine with <b>a negative test result</b>	10-day isolation
Can return after 10-day quarantine with <b>NO COVID test result</b>	Must return with a negative test result



#### **Google Classroom Assignments**

Teachers will list the directions for assignments and any resources needed to complete the assignments in Google Classroom. Teachers are strongly encouraged to use the academic apps in MyBackpack to provide assignments and also attach any supporting videos and links so that students have full access and necessary support to complete assignments.

Students will log into Zoom for academic support from 4:30PM to 5:30PM on Wednesdays during afterschool tutorials. Students can access after school tutorials through Google Classroom.

#### \*Special Education and ESOL

 If the whole class is quarantined, Special Education and ESOL teachers will access the homeroom teacher's Zoom link to join a breakout room with individual or small groups of students. This will allow them to provide services as needed.

#### \*Connection Teachers:

• Connection teachers will post assignments, videos and links for students in Google Classroom.

#### \*Google Classroom Assignments:

Once a student has been documented as quarantined, teachers will notify parents that assignments are posted in Google Classroom and post this contact in Infinite Campus.

If a student has not completed assignments in Google Classroom, teachers will do the following:

- 3rd day: Contact the parent and document this information in the Infinite Campus contact log
- 5th day: Contact counselor (Mr. Fears, Ms. Watkins)
- 7th day: Contact social worker (Ms. Thomas)

\*<u>Please note</u>: If the parent states that the student has been sick, this will be documented in the Infinite Campus contact log and the student will be allowed to complete the assignments when they are feeling better.
