Achievement Gap:

To improve overall student achievement, J. E. Brown Middle School will focus on:

1. Narrowing the achievement gap between Regular Ed students and Special Ed students.
2. Increase the percent of students scoring at Developing Learner or above on the GA Milestones
 - ELA(English Language Arts) from 43% to 46%;
 - Math from 43% to 46%;
 - Science from 19% to 22%;
 - Social Studies from 65% to 68%

In the Classroom

The teachers will work with students and their families to support students' success in all content areas. Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Parent/teacher conferences (also via phone and emails) & in-class parent shadowing to provide assist to their student with homework, as well as learn themselves.
- Identify student's individual needs & implement research based instructional strategies by equipping students with knowledge of their academic and attendance standing while making individual goals for themselves alongside their parents to improve test scores, behavior, and attendance.

At Home

J. E. Brown Middle School parents are encouraged to become and remain actively involved in their student's education.

Parents can/will:

- Participate in student's homework activities/discussions through educational software that can be used in class and continued at home (Power My Learning, Google Classroom, Reading Plus, Moby Max,).
- Check student's progress on parent portal and My Backpack to ensure that the student is on target and progressing.
- Participate in online parent workshops via social media/conference calls to increase their reading and math skills on a regular basis.

J. E. Brown Middle School students regularly discuss with staff and parents ways they can succeed in school academically and socially. Some student ideas and suggestions are:

- Actively participate in class and work with my teachers and other resources to ensure academic success. Showcase abilities to parents/guardians.
- Utilize Moby Max, and other resources to improve my math skills and reading skills.
- Take advantage of all instructional opportunities in class and afterschool programs to ensure that I meet/exceed on the Georgia Milestone and academically.
- Participate in tutorials and extra-curricular activities that will enhance my ability to do well in math, science, social studies and language arts, and promote academic excellence.
