Important information when communicating with families:

- This summer, the GoSTEAM Program at Georgia Tech will provide a full scholarship for your child to participate in a one-week STEAM virtual summer camp with Georgia Tech-CEISMC or the Alliance Theatre.

No supplies are needed for the Georgia Tech camp; only access to a device.
