A Tradition of Professional Treatment

Talbott Recovery was born out of necessity. Its Founder, Dr. G. Douglas Talbott, experienced addiction and found that getting help as a licensed professional was a challenge. In 1989, he opened a facility specifically for licensed professionals, becoming a pioneering voice for the treatment of addiction and co-occurring disorders. Today, Talbott Recovery has expanded its programming to offer services for other licensed professions such as nurses, lawyers and pilots, as well as programs for standard adult and young adults.



A Place to Rediscover Yourself

Talbott Recovery's campus is located on over 120 acres of land, featuring a 30-acre, spring-fed lake, that allows for the opportunity of outdoor therapies. This peaceful area provides an environment to help individuals establish a foundation for long-term recovery. Indoors is a beautiful space flooded with natural light. Every area throughout the campus is intentional and offers the opportunity to heal.
