Purpose



All Title I schools are required to hold an Annual Title I meeting at the beginning of each school year to....

- Inform parents/guardians about Title I programming, and
- Share how parents/guardians can become involved and participate in the Title I program. Our school offers workshops, trainings, and parent/teacher conferences at flexible meeting times that will be available to parents via the school calendar and a Parent Resource Center/Area;

Goals of Title I

- to provide direct instructional support to students.
- to provide professional development for teachers.
- to promote parent education and involvement
- Provide parents and family members with timely information about Title I programs; Parents will be informed through flyers, Parent Liaison Newsletter, school calendar, Robo-calls messages and the school's website.



What is Title I?



Title I is:

- A federally funded educational program.
- Provides supplemental funds to districts to assist schools with the highest student concentrations of economic hardship
- Provides supplemental funds to districts to assist schools with concentrations of economic hardship to meet school educational goals.
- We are a school receiving federal funds for Title I students.
- ESSA includes provisions that will help to ensure success for students and schools.

HOW DOES OUR SCHOOL PARTICIPATE IN THE TITLE I PROGRAM?

- A Title 1 schoolwide program is a comprehensive reform strategy designed to upgrade the entire educational program in a Title 1 school.
- Primary goal is to ensure that all students, particularly those who are low-achieving, demonstrate proficient and advanced levels of achievement on state academic standards.

Parent's Right to Know

Parents have the right to know about the teaching qualifications of your child's classroom teacher in a school receiving Title I funds

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO KNOW

- Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived;
- Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher; and
- Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

ESSA Section 1112 (e) (1) (A)

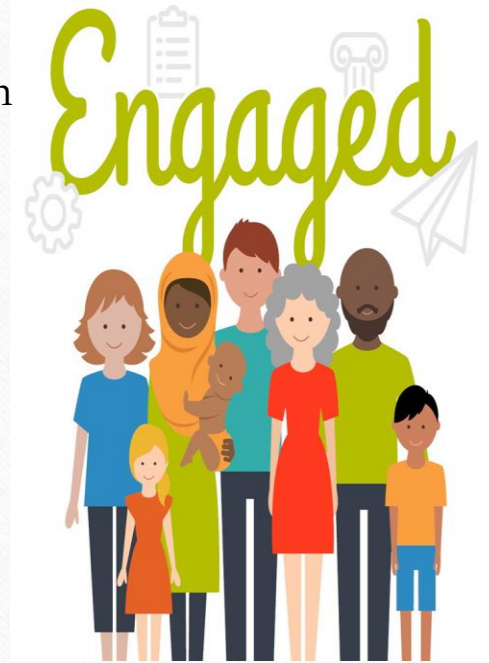
