PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Child must turn four years old by September 1, 2020
- Child must live within the APS attendance zone



HOW TO APPLY

- Pre-K lottery applications accepted January 6 through February 12, 2020
- Apply online at apsprekapplication.com starting at 9 am (eastern time) on January 6, 2020
- A valid email address is required to apply
- Applications must be received by 11:59 pm (eastern time) on February 12, 2020



LOTTERY DRAWING

- The lottery drawing will be held on February 24, 2020
- Lottery drawing results will be emailed to all applicants after verification process. Pending official verification, lottery results could be delayed.

IF SELECTED, THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ENROLLMENT:

- ☐ Child's original birth certificate or passport; copies **are not** accepted.
- ☐ Proof of legal guardianship (if applicable).
 - Only required if your name is not on the child's birth certificate.
- ☐ Parent/guardian I.D.
 - State I.D., passport, or driver's license
- ☐ Proof of residency
 - Lease, mortgage statement, or utility bill in parent/guardian name (cable and phone bills **are not** accepted)
 - If you are living with someone and do not have a lease or utility bill in your name, you will need a notarized affidavit of residency, three forms of mail in your name **AND** the most recent lease/utility bill in the name of the person you are living with.
- ☐ Child's original social security card
- ☐ Child's health insurance card
- ☐ Proof of food stamps, Medicaid, TANF (if applicable) Immunization certificate (Form 3231)
- ☐ Ear, eye, and dental screening (Form 3300)
- ☐ Proof of income – **Head Start sites ONLY****
 - 2019 W2, tax return, or SSI, TANF, or child support
