- Make literacy a priority across all content areas by:
  - Implementing a meaningful literacy/math block (Success For All/Power Teaching Math)intervention in order to focus on reading and math
  - Incorporating writing throughout all content areas
  - Integrate Close Reading Annotation Strategies in ELA, Social Studies, and Science classrooms in order for students to comprehend complex texts.
- Provide 21<sup>st</sup> Century literature to increase students' interest in reading
- Ensure literacy curriculum and math workshops are included in the Parent Engagement Program
- Host Parent-Teacher Conferences weekly and provide opportunities for parents to meet with ELA and Math teachers specifically.
