Being in school all day, every day, helps your child get the most out of middle school. Encourage good attendance with these ideas:

- Point out that there is no substitute for being in class. Students need to learn lessons, participate in class discussions, and to ask questions.
- Schedule doctor appointments before or after school hours or during breaks whenever possible.
- It will be easier for your child to get up on time for school if they have had at least nine hours of sleep. Set a reasonable bedtime, and make sure they put away cell phones to avoid playing games or visiting social media.
