- □ Parent/guardian I.D.
 - · State I.D., passport, or driver's license
- □ Proof of residency
 - Lease, mortgage statement, AND Georgia Power bill in parent/guardian name (cable, phone, water, and gas bills are not accepted).
 - If you are living with someone you will need the following:
 - A valid lease/mortgage statement AND Georgia Power bill in the homeowner's name.
 - · A declaration of residency.
 - Three forms of mail in your name with the homeowner's address.

- ☐ Child's health insurance card
- □ Proof of food stamps, Medicaid, TANF (if applicable)
- □ Immunization certificate (Form 3231)
- ☐ Ear, eye, and dental screening (Form 3300)
- □ Proof of income **Head Start sites ONLY****
