PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Child must turn four years old by September 1, 2023
- Child must live within the APS attendance zone



HOW TO APPLY

- Pre-K lottery applications accepted January 16 through March 12, 2023
- Apply online at enrollearlyatl.com starting at 9 am (eastern time) on January 16, 2023
- A valid email address is required to apply
- Applications must be received by 11:59 pm (eastern time) on March 12, 2023



LOTTERY DRAWING

- The lottery drawing will be held on March 27, 2023
- Lottery drawing results will be emailed to all applicants after verification process. Pending official verification, lottery results could be delayed.

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ENROLLMENT:

- ☐ Child's original birth certificate or passport; copies **are not** accepted.
- ☐ Proof of legal guardianship (if applicable).
 - Only required if your name is not on the child's birth certificate.
- ☐ Parent/guardian I.D.
 - State I.D., passport, or driver's license
- ☐ Proof of residency
 - Lease, mortgage statement, AND Georgia Power bill in parent/guardian name (cable, phone, water, and gas bills **are not** accepted).
 - If you are living with someone you will need the following:
 - A valid lease/mortgage statement **AND** Georgia Power bill in the homeowner's name.
 - A declaration of residency.
 - Three forms of mail in your name with the homeowner's address.
- ☐ Child's original social security card
- ☐ Child's health insurance card
- ☐ Proof of food stamps, Medicaid, TANF (if applicable)
- ☐ Immunization certificate (Form 3231)
- ☐ Ear, eye, and dental screening (Form 3300)
- ☐ Proof of income – **Head Start sites ONLY****
 - 2022 W2, tax return, or SSI, TANF, or child support
