Elementary K-5

Early Literacy/ELA

Grade Level	Curriculum Resource/Program	Curriculum Resource Description
K - 2 nd (some 3 rd graders)	I-Read	Provides a systematic sequence of explicit, recursive instruction with mastery-based interactive practice in early literacy. <i>iRead</i> employs a combination of personalized learning, embedded assessment, technology, and the opportunity for small-group instruction to support student needs.
3 rd -5 th	System 44	Combines adaptive technology and teacher-led instruction to help students become proficient readers, writers, speakers, and critical thinkers. The goal of System 44 is to ensure that each student masters the system of 44 sounds and 26 letters that constitute the English language, allowing them to become fluent and confident readers.
3 rd – 5 th	Read 180	Provides an individualized and personalized pathway that blends adaptive instructional software; high-interest text selections; and whole- and small-group data- driven, teacher-led instruction that targets the vital areas of reading, writing, language and vocabulary, and speaking and listening.

Math

K - 5 th	Do The Math	Provides flexible, classroom-tested instruction for building numerical reasoning and confidence. Do The Math teaches students the basics of mathematics – computation, number sense, and problem solving. It helps students develop the understanding and skills they need to compute with accuracy and efficiency, the number sense they need to reason, and the ability to apply their skills and reasoning to solve problems.
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Middle School (6-8)

6 th – 8 th	Read 180	Provides an individualized and personalized pathway that blends adaptive instructional software; high-interest text selections; and whole- and small-group data- driven, teacher-led instruction that targets the vital areas of reading, writing, language and vocabulary, and speaking and listening.

6 th – 8 th	Math 180	Builds conceptual understanding and fluency with whole numbers, fractions, decimals, and integers through a carefully sequenced and paced progression of content.

9 th – 12 th	Read 180	Provides intensive intervention to help students in Grades 4–12 who are more than one or two years behind become accomplished readers.

9 th (Algebra 1 ONLY)	Math 180	Empowers struggling students as they gain understanding and mastery of the essential skills and concepts necessary to unlock algebra and advanced mathematics.
10 th – 11 th	APEX Learning Geometry & Algebra II	Provides teachers with engaging, standards-based content that can be integrated with classroom instruction. The curriculum is designed to meet specific needs of students and has built in scaffolds and supports to enrich students who may be struggling.

K - 12 th	MAP Growth	MAP is a nationally norm-referenced assessment used to identify a student’s achievement level compared to students at that grade level across the nation. MAP will be administered at least three times a year to get an accurate view of how much each student has grown over time and what students are ready to learn – so you can plan for instruction and group students based on their specific needs.
K – 2 (some third graders)	MAP Reading Fluency	MAP Reading Fluency is an online, adaptive benchmark and progress monitoring assessment of oral reading fluency, literal comprehension, and foundational reading skills. *Note: Students in K-2 will take both MAP Reading Fluency and MAP Growth Reading which addresses the breadth of reading skills outside of oral reading fluency.
