



## Booker T. Washington High School Virtual Learning Plan

In instances of high spread that predicated a closure of a classroom, grade level, sports team or the entire school, the following plans will be implemented to support student virtual learning:

### Technology Distribution:

By now, your student should have been issued a device. If their device is lost, stolen or damaged, they can retrieve a loaner device from the school on Monday-Wednesdays from 9:00a.m. – 3:30p.m. Students who've never received a device may also pick one up during those times. Technology will be distributed at the security check point (1<sup>st</sup> floor, under the stairs) by a member of our tech team. Students are encouraged to bring their damaged devices with them, so that they can be submitted for repair while using the loaner.

### Accessing New Schedules:

Your student should be able to access their spring term schedule through infinite campus. This will help them determine which classes they will need to retrieve google classroom codes for. If your student cannot access infinite campus, please have them reach out to Ms. K. King-Taylor through the **BTW**

*For Clarity:*

**Quarantine** keeps someone who might have been exposed to the virus away from others. People up-to-date on vaccines and those who are within 90 days of a previous COVID-19 infection do not need to quarantine. APS currently has a "Test to Stay" Modified Quarantine Option. Your student may participate in Test to Stay if they meet ALL of the following criteria:

- Their COVID-19 exposure occurred at school or a school-related activity
- Has NO new symptoms (e.g., fever, cough, difficulty breathing, vomiting, diarrhea)
- Can be tested during their quarantine period at least twice\* either through APS Surveillance Testing or through a test monitored by a healthcare or lab professional (must provide a copy of the result to the school)
- Can wear a well-fitting mask for the full 10 days after exposure (except to during lunch, nap time, or while drinking)

### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

**What happens if an entire class is quarantined due to COVID cases or exposures including the teacher?** A long-term substitute or building-level designee will be assigned to deliver instruction virtually.



### **What happens if one or more students test positive for COVID (unrelated cases)?**

Teachers will place current academic work in an electronic repository (Google Classroom) and a teacher/tutor will provide after school tutoring for students through our RISE program offered Monday – Thursday from 4:00p.m. – 6:00p.m. virtually. Students will be able to join sessions that support learning and understanding of the courses they are currently enrolled in.

### **What happens if a teacher tests positive for COVID and there is no evidence of student exposure?**

A long-term substitute or building-level designee will be assigned to the teacher's classroom. Current substitute teacher plans will be used during the quarantine period for students affected.

**What happens in the event of a whole school or district closure due to a COVID outbreak?** The entire school will pivot to virtual learning, please see our standing plans for school closure. Logging in to the BTW google classroom should be the normed response in instances of a school wide, grade level or classroom closure is.
