# ABCDE Updates

## Attendance

- ▶ Meeting with Social Worker Robinson weekly provides LIVE data on attendance issues (referral to WCI, Chris180, community support programs, etc.)

## Behavior

- ▶ Meeting with Assistant Principal Jones weekly provides LIVE data on behavioral issues
  - ▶ Check correlation between attendance and grades/credits
- ▶ Meeting with the counselor when a student returns from ISS or OSS to discuss decisions/consequences



## Credits

- ▶ Counselor meets with Credit recovery and AVA students **bi-weekly** to monitor progress
- ▶ Individual graduation plan meetings-**once per semester**
- ▶ Group graduation checklist meetings-**once per month**
  - ▶ Students are grouped according to GPAs/RANK (allows for conversations to be based on selecting the correct “match” colleges)

## Dropouts

- ▶ Meeting with Social Worker Robinson & Registrar Amos monthly will provide information on students to decrease the number of dropouts
