

Grad Rate - APS 2018 Cohort by School Grad Rates Over Time






Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity: APS and Cluster






EOG Milestones Results: Finch & Gideons 2018 Percentage Proficient and Above






EOG Milestones Results: Perkerson & Slater 2018 Percentage Proficient and Above







EOG Milestones Results: Price & Sylvan 2018 Percentage Proficient and Above






High School EOC Milestones Results 2018 Percentage Proficient and Above



Performance Drill Down: CCRPI

- GaDOE gives each school a score based on a 100-point index
- Includes many indicators but Milestones matters the most
- Because of updates to calculations, the standard CCRPI score is not comparable across years but the state percentile rank of scores is.


Percentage of students who graduate high school in four years






