#### Priority 1: Student Attendance Action Step:

 Decrease chronic absenteeism rate among 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students by 5% with a specific focus on implementing targeted interventions for students experiencing housing instability, to ensure equitable access to education for all students.

#### Priority 2: Student Failure Rate Action Step:

1. By the end of the semester, the percentage of students failing Algebra I will decrease 5% through targeted interventions and differentiated instruction, ensuring all students, including exceptional education scholars, have access to necessary support to achieve proficiency, as measured by unit assessments and progress monitoring.
