Expectations in the classroom

- Teachers and students will use hand sanitizer upon entering the classroom each day.
- All classrooms will have socially distant fixed seating.
- Students must always sit in the same place.
- Desks and chairs must not be moved from their location.
- To maximize social distancing, teachers should avoid movement during lessons and remain near the screen. Likewise, to ensure proper virtual learning, teachers must maintain communication with virtual learners.
- Group activities and any close contact between individuals should be avoided.
- Equipment and supplies should not be shared.

Student Expectations

- Use sanitizer to disinfect hands upon entering and leaving the classroom each day.
- Wash hands with soap regularly throughout the day, as permitted.
- In the classroom, always sit in the same place.
- Do not move tables or chairs.
- Maintain a safe distance from others in the classroom.
- Do not share belongings with others.

Cleaning

- Cleaners will disinfect and wipe down all surfaces:
 - > Entrances to the building, main office, and stair railings
 - > Entrances to classrooms (door handles, etc....)
 - Classroom desks
 - ➤ Toilets
- On Wednesdays and Fridays, there will be a deep clean of all spaces and surfaces in the school.

Front Office

- The front office should be used to only 50% of its capacity at most.
- Principals' Conference Room will not be utilized for meeting unless social distancing is possible.
- Staff members should only utilize District issued computers that are designated to them.
- Staff members should use hand sanitizer when entering and leaving the front office.

Actions if a pupil or staff member shows Covid19 symptoms

Student or staff member displays Covid symptoms.



Send home and advise to self- isolate for 7 days. Household members should selfisolate for 7 days. Encourage to get tested. If the test is negative, return to school and the household ends selfisolation. If the test is positive, move to the confirmed case scenario.

Actions if there is a confirmed case of Covid19



Individual receives medical advice and/or treatment.

Class or group sent home and told to selfisolate for 14 days. If other cases are detected within the school, the District will investigate and advise.

CONSOLIDATED RE-ENTRY PLAN

- To ensure proper compliance to Covid 19 screening, as well as District protocol, EVERYONE will enter the building through the main entrance. Everyone <u>must wear a mask</u> to enter the building. Arrival times will be staggered to ensure proper screening. NO ONE will enter the building without proper screening (temperature check, screening questions).
- All Staff (Virtual & In-Person) is expected to be in place by 7:30a.m. daily. Staff must be prepared to receive students, support daily duties, and ensure an efficient and seamless learning environment.
- Upon arrival, students will exit the bus and have their temperature taken.
- Students will be checked for a mask. If the student does not have a mask, one will be provided.
- Some areas of the school will become one-way. Specifically, students entering the building from buses. Students will enter through the lower lobby and proceed pass the gymnasium, turning onto the fifth-grade hall. Students will descend the stairs and proceed to their classroom.
