HEALTH AND WELLNESS INITIATIVE

- We are a NUT-FREE school. Please do not send in any products with nuts in your child's lunchbox, as this places other children in danger.
- Sending a snack with your child? Please make it a healthy one! Your child is in school 6.5 hours a day. He/She needs to sustain a high energy level so that we can support his/her academic, behavioral, and social success.
- We do not allow kids to share food. Please send single serving items for lunch.
- We have 20 minutes of recess daily, as long as weather permits. If the weather is a roadblock, we enjoy 20 minutes of indoor recess. Recess removal as a consequence is reserved for recess-related offenses (no more than half of recess missed) or as a consequence for physical aggression.
- We will have a full-time nurse beginning next week!

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

- K-5 will be teaching six planners based on Georgia Standards
- We are in the candidacy phase.
- Authorization Applications submitted by April 1, 2019.
- Full-time IB Specialist who works with grade levels weekly.
- Pre-k exposure to IB learner profile attributes.
- Report card behavior will be the learner profile traits.

SCHOOL SAFETY

- We have protocols in place for every type of emergency that might occur. We do not publish these safety plans due to the sensitivity. Your child will participate in fire evacuations, earthquake drills, intruder drills, and reverse evacuations this year. This is something we must do to ensure that every student has practice in case of a real emergency.
- NEVER prop a door open at the school. This is a serious safety issue. We prop doors during morning and afternoon dismissal, only with a staff member present at the door.
- You may walk your child to class up until 8:00 a.m.; this is when instructional time begins. Please exit the building immediately when announcements begin unless you have pre-arranged to volunteer with a staff member. All volunteers must secure a Visitor's Pass in the front office.
