Two telehealth access options:





Physical Health: On-campus virtual urgent care within 3-5 minutes

Mental Health: Scheduled teletherapy sessions while student is at school

Hazel at Home



Services also available at home with students' parents or guardians,

7 AM - 5 PM local time (Physical Health) 7 AM - 7 PM local time (Mental Health)

Services Provided:

- Physical Health: Virtual urgent medical care for allergies, pink eye, pains, bumps & bruises
- Mental Health: Short-term counseling/teletherapy sessions with licensed therapists

Benefits:

- Increased return to class rate and learning time
- Fewer missed work hours for parents
- Over 50% providers who are people of color and are bilingual
- \$0 out-of-pocket cost for families

School-based Teams:

- Principals are our Telehealth champions! They help to spread the word to families.
- Referral and Initiation Team: **Physical Health** (school nurses), **Mental Health** (school counselors, social workers)

District Rollout Timeline:

- October 2022: Phase I Clusters (Douglass, Jackson, North Atlanta, South Atlanta, Therrell)
- November 2022: Phase II Clusters (Carver, Midtown, Mays, Washington, and Non-traditional schools)
