Our third and fourth grade students are performing in the top 20 schools for Atlanta Public Schools (APS) on the MAP Assessment which is the district's benchmark assessment. Our staff is working diligently to ensure that all of the grade levels perform in the top 20 for APS by the end of the school year. Our daily attendance average is growing each month because parents like you value the importance of your scholars being in school every day to learn. Please know that if you get the scholars here, we will do everything in our power to ensure that they have the best educational experience possible.

#### What to Expect this October

Fall is officially here! Once the students return from Fall Break on October 12th, you can expect that your scholars will be diving into their MAP data reports, setting instructional goals, and working hard to meet those goals each and every day. Teachers should begin reaching out to parents to schedule parent teacher conferences to review student performance for the first semester. Conferences will be scheduled virtually in an effort to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in our building. Please note that quarter 1 report cards will be available in Infinite Campus on October 15th. We are excited about teachers spending this time with you and allowing us to be a part of your village.


