Please consult with your doctor or local public health department and submit an updated Certificate (Form 3231) immediately. As required under Georgia Code (OCGA §20-2-771) your child may be excluded from school or childcare if this information is not received. The Code also states "... any parent or guardian who intentionally does not comply with the Code section, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 12 months."

Failure to provide this record will result in the immediate withdrawal of your child from school on September 22, 2023; and a referral will be made to the school social worker.
