

Dear Parents,

As the end of the year is quickly approaching, we are collecting your student's Digital Bridge device for summer maintenance. It is imperative that the student devices are returned so that APS IT can update the applications and make any other needed repairs to the devices.

Your student should bring the laptop, power brick and cord, as well as the T-Mobile hotspot and digital ink pen if assigned. King is collecting devices May 14th – May 17th. Your student should give the laptop and accessories to Ms. George, Mrs. Swinson and Mr. Dow. We will give you proof of receipt when turning in the device.

As stated in the Digital Bridge Handbook, any device that is not returned will be assessed a fee for replacement unless the parent submits a police report citing a lost or stolen device. Additionally, if the device is not returned students will incur a debt with Atlanta Public Schools. The fee schedule is as follows:
