Dear King Parent or Guardian,

Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School will be implementing the district-wide intervention plan to provide face-to-face instruction with selected students from November 16-January 8 (following the APS student calendar). King's intervention plan will be targeting our students with hearing impairments and severe disabilities. This intervention will be in alignment with the Atlanta Public Schools health and safety protocols.

We will also implement an additional plan to support some of our other students. The students selected for this intervention are currently being served in SST on Tier 2 or Tier 3. We will provide additional virtual support for those students on Tuesdays and Thursdays from December 1- January 8 (following the APS student calendar) from 4:30pm-6:30pm. This targeted intervention will not replace core instruction. Students are still expected to attend and participate in their regularly scheduled classes during the school day. Teachers will be reaching out to you if your student falls into this category to schedule their tutoring time. The students will be seen, virtually, in groups of two for thirty-minute sessions of intensive instruction in critical need areas.

Thank you, again, and we appreciate your continued support of our effort to provide a high-quality education for our students in any instructional model.
