

# WHAT IS TITLE I?



Title I is the largest federally funded program for elementary, middle, and high schools. Title I helps students, teachers, and parents!

Through Title I, money is given to school districts around the country based on the number of low-income families in each district. Each district uses its Title I money for extra educational services for children most in need of educational help. The focus of the Title I program is on helping these students meet the same high standards expected of all children.

# BMS & TITLE 1 FUNDS

## INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORTS

- Tutoring Programs: After-school, Saturday, or online tutoring to reinforce core subjects like math, reading, and science.
- Small Group Instruction: Funding for materials and staffing to provide personalized learning support.
- Enrichment Activities: STEM clubs, literacy programs, or project-based learning experiences.

## TECHNOLOGY & RESOURCES

- Student Devices: Laptops, Chromebooks, or tablets to ensure students have access to digital learning tools.
- Educational Software & Platforms: Programs like i-Ready, IXL, Nearpod, or Study Island for personalized learning.

## FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

- Workshops for Parents: Sessions on topics like homework help, digital literacy, or social-emotional learning.
- Parent Resource Center: Creating a dedicated space with books, guides, and materials parents can use at home.

## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Culturally Responsive Teaching: Equipping teachers with strategies to support diverse learners.
- Curriculum & Assessment Training: Helping teachers implement new instructional strategies or improve assessment practices.
- Conference Attendance: Providing staff opportunities to attend educational conferences that align with school goals.


