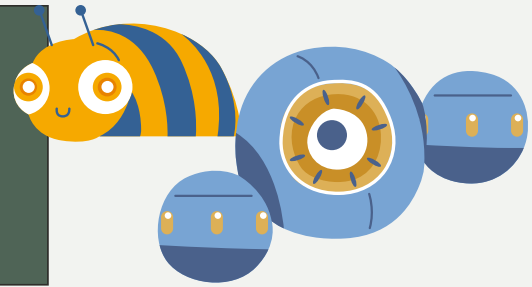

HERE IS WHAT'S HAPPENING IN THE STEAM LAB!

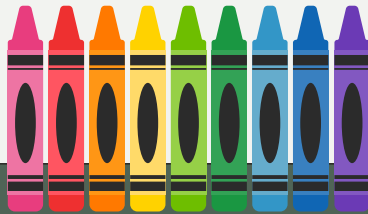
KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten is studying Living and Non-Living things and how to classify them. They are also learning how to CODE using the beebots and Sphero Indy.



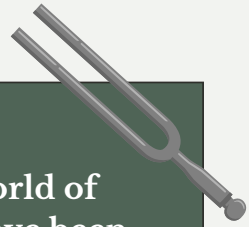
SECOND

Second Graders are creating new crayon colors and adding our adventures to the book "The Day the Crayons Came Home" by Drew Daywalt.



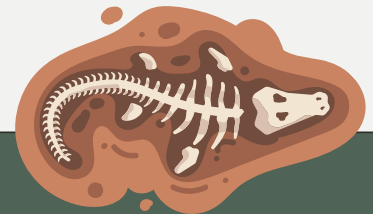
FIRST

The Third Grade Paleontologist team has been busy trying to replicate some fossils that got damaged right before the big Museum opening!



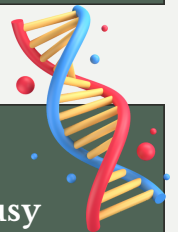
FOURTH
