Welcome to IB Art year 2! As you know, IB Art is an exciting class based around deep investigation of past and current artists, appreciation of different cultures and ideas, exploration of all kinds of artistic mediums (both conventional and non-conventional), and thoughtful reflection on your impact on the world as an artist.

Successful students:

- work many hours outside of the scheduled class time on artwork, research and investigation
- are thoughtful in the concepts behind their work
- try new mediums and techniques that may be outside the comfort zone
- are motivated, open to feedback, positive, and give thoughtful feedback

Materials:

- 1) A hardbound Sketchbook 8.5" x 11" is mandatory. They can be purchased at Sam Flax. (if you use your one from year 1 that is fine... but you may need to get another if it's getting full or falling apart)
- 2) Lab fee \$20.00 - due the first week of school

*All other materials will be supplied unless they are too complex for the art classroom environment.

Summer Homework: Due on the first day of School

- 1) **Create 1 artwork revolving around your theme – 100 pts Summative**
 - The work should be **complete and refined**. No in process works.
 - Be as involved and thoughtful as a work would be that has been completed in class
 - 2) **Sketchbook & Process Pictures for your artwork – 100 pts Formative**
 - 5 full-size thumbnails for your summer project or other ideas for future projects ready to present and discuss (mostly based around your theme, but it's ok to explore other ideas too). – 50 pts
 - TAKE PROCESS PICTURES... Plan to show your work! – sketches, ideas, thoughts and investigations, any artists/ inspiration/research, reference images etc. **about the artwork you created** over the summer – **upload at least 10 images of your process** to the google classroom assignment (these images can include references images, inspirations, sketches, your tools/mediums, step by step creating process, any issues you run into, etc.) *You can upload as individual images, or put into a doc.* – 50 pts
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- 3) **Finish Comparative Study - Due August 24th (2 weeks into the 1st Semester)**
 - This is not summer homework, but I've included it if you want to get a head start. You've already selected your artworks, done a full analysis of one of them, and created an artwork that was inspired by all 3. By August 24th, you should submit your completed Comparative Study. All criteria and helpful tips can be found on your Google Classroom.
 - HL students must include additional slides of your own artwork inspired by the 3 artworks (which should be already complete). ***Please refer to the rubric for criteria, we will also discuss this in class.***
