

Carver Early College COVID-19 Senior Portrait Guidelines

In order to maintain the safety and well being of all students and staff please adhere to the guidelines below.

- Students must come during their scheduled appointment time and leave immediately after their photo session.
- Temperatures will be taken upon arrival.
- APS Board Policy requires a mask to be worn by anyone entering the building.
- **Students may have only one family member to accompany them. This person may assist with grooming or fixing apparel.**
- Students must sit the designated socially distanced waiting areas.
- Ladies must provide their own accessories. It is recommended, but not required that ladies wear small stud earrings and a pearl necklace.
- Appointment times cannot be altered. If an emergency arises, please have your parent(s) call Carver Early College or email Dr. Landsman at mhouston@apsk12.org.
- Students must come "camera ready". There are no designated spaces for hairstylists or make-up artists.
- **Students, parents, staff and stakeholders must be aware of the Georgia law for entering public buildings during the COVID-19 pandemic:**

"Under Georgia law there is no liability for an injury or death of an individual entering these premises if such injury or death results from the inherent risks of contracting COVID-19. You are assuming this risk by entering these premises."

Prestige Portraits COVID-19 Guidelines

- All photographers will have a no touch (6ft social distance) policy.
- All employees will wear masks when engaging with a student or family member.
- All employees will have hand sanitizer and wipes to clean surfaces when compromised.
- Photography stations will be separated as much as possible (a minimum of 12ft. between stations).
- All clothing will be disinfected between student use (garments will be steamed between subjects).
- All grooming, apparel adjustments, or posing will be verbally communicated. Any touching will have to be done by a family member.
